WHO: Any student in grades K-12 may submit artwork for display at the Salt Fork Arts & Crafts Festival. Students must live in or be enrolled in schools in Guernsey or surrounding counties.

WHAT: Students may enter two pieces of art per person. High school seniors who wish to enter the scholarship competition must enter five pieces and complete a separate application. All entries must be original in design and concept, and, if two dimensional, must be matted or framed for hanging.

WHEN: All entries will be picked up by a representative of the Salt Fork Arts and Crafts Festival by July 15. Arrangements will be made with school districts in Guernsey, Noble, and Muskingum counties for art pickup at the end of the school year. HOW TO ENTER

1. Students should select the piece(s) of work they would like to submit and complete the registration form. Entry forms and artwork should be submitted to a district representative or the SFACF Student Art Representative.
2. All flat pieces must be able to be hung on a pegboard for display. Pieces may be framed or backed by heavy material such as construction paper, foam board, or posterboard.
3. Selected artwork will be displayed in the Student Art Tent throughout the entirety of the Salt Fork Arts and Crafts Festival, August 14-16, 2025.
4. Displayed artwork will be judged on Friday August 14th, and must be picked up at the Student Art Tent no later than 3:00 p.m. on Sunday August 16th. Art may be picked up by the artist, the artist's family, or a district representative. The Student Art Awards are tentatively planned for Sunday August 16th.
